as a Resource

- ✓ ComEd's Progress
- ✓ PECO's Progress
- ✓ Future Opportunities/Challenges

- ✓ Enrolled 61,140 participant locations (4,524 commercial & industrial, 56,616 residential) in load reduction programs representing 1,296 MW of potential resources (1,193 MW commercial & industrial, 103 MW residential)

- ✓ Launched CARE (Customers' Affordable Reliable Energy) Program
 - Showcase of Homes – energy makeovers for 6 of 12 typical Chicago homes
 - Discounted 1.3 million CFLs as part of Change a Light, Change the World program
 - Web-based education and awareness program

- ✓ **Enrolled 59,976 participant locations (4,166 C&I and 55,810 residential) in load reduction programs for 1,123 MW of potential peak load reduction (1,042 MW C&I and 81 MW residential)**
 - Outstanding Achievement in Demand Response Award from PLMA

- ✓ **Engaged with other IL stakeholders on energy efficiency legislation**
 - DR at .1% per year
 - EE at .2% of load growth in 2008, .4% in 2009, 1% by 2012, 2% by 2015
 - Rate cap of .5% rate cap of previous year's bill, increasing by .5% each year for three years, thereafter capped at 2.015% of previous year's total bill

- ✓ **Filing 3-year plan to respond to legislation in November for first year delivery of programs in June 2008**

- ✓ **Launched a residential dynamic pricing program**

- ✓ **Continued CARE Program**
 - Completed remaining 6 homes in Showcase of Homes and will participate in Change a Light, Change the World

- ✓ Enrolled 79 C&I customers with load reduction potential of 285 MW

- ✓ Launched web-based customer education and awareness program
 - PECO Energy Saver kits to residential gas customers
 - On-line energy store
 - Partnership with Energy Association of Philadelphia to provide rebates of up to \$700 for high efficiency air conditioners and heat pumps

- ✓ Assisted more than 8,000 qualified natural gas and electrical residential customers through Low Income Usage Reduction Program (LIURP)

- ✓ Enrolled 130 C&I customers with load reduction potential of 337 MW
- ✓ Continued web-based customer education and awareness program
 - PECO Energy Saver kits to residential electrical customers
- ✓ LIURP wins ACEEE award as one of the nation's most exemplary energy efficiency programs
- ✓ Engaged with other PA stakeholders in Governor's Energy Independence Strategy

- ✓ Renovated Chicago headquarters to US Green Building Council LEED standard
 - Platinum designation for remodeled commercial interior space
 - Expected electricity savings of 43% relative to old space and based on eight months of data expect savings of 50%

- ✓ Administrative buildings at ComEd and PECO have reduced total energy usage by 10.8% between 2003 and 2006
 - On track to meet 2007 goal

- ✓ Good execution of customer programs in IL
- ✓ Decoupling/performance incentives
- ✓ Outcome of discussions in PA on possible energy efficiency and demand response legislation
- ✓ Integration of CO2 savings associated with customer-based energy efficiency programs into federal cap-and-trade legislation
 - possible offsets ?
