2002 Ratepayer Funding for Energy Efficiency - SBC



New York:	State authorities	▲	\$220 million/year
Massachusetts:	Utility programs	▲	\$130 million/year
New Jersey:	Utility programs	▲	\$101 million/year
Connecticut:	Utility programs	▲	\$83 million/year
Rhode Island:	Utility programs	▲	\$17 million/year
Vermont:	Efficiency Utility	▲	\$13 million/year
New Hampshire:	Utility programs	▲	\$12 million/year
Maine:	Public Utility Comm	▲	\$2.5 million/year
PA & MD:	Low income program funding only (non-SBC)

- 📄 SBC funds renewed - MA, RI
- 📄 Statewide admin - NY, NJ, NH, CT, VT, RI, ME
- 📄 Building energy codes updated - most states
- 📄 Minimum product efficiency standards legislation *proposed* - MD, CT, RI
- 📄 State purchasing standards - NY, CT
- 📄 Green Buildings Tax Credits - MD, NY
- 📄 New England Demand Response Initiative



What's New for MT in the Northeast in 2002?

- Multi-Year regional evaluation plan - NEEP
- Multi-State market share tracking - MA, NJ
- Industry initiated campaigns - lighting, appliances, windows, motors
- Midstream assessment - motors, unitary HVAC
- DesignLights Consortium - targeted marketing
- Program focus on high performance schools



What's New for MT in the Northeast in 2002?

- Builder energy code “plus” training using ENERGY STAR® homes - five states
- New commercial energy code - NY, NJ, MD, PA - regional input to IECC 2003
- Retro-commissioning Training in development - BOC Series 300
- Residential HVAC - adding duct sealing
- Northeast States Efficiency Standards Project
